The 3" SDR-7 poly-pipe has a maximum working pressure of 260 psi at 74° F. It is our intention to operate the line at ± 50 psi. The attached plat prepared by Texakoma Oil & Gas Corporation illustrates the proposed location of the Gathering line.

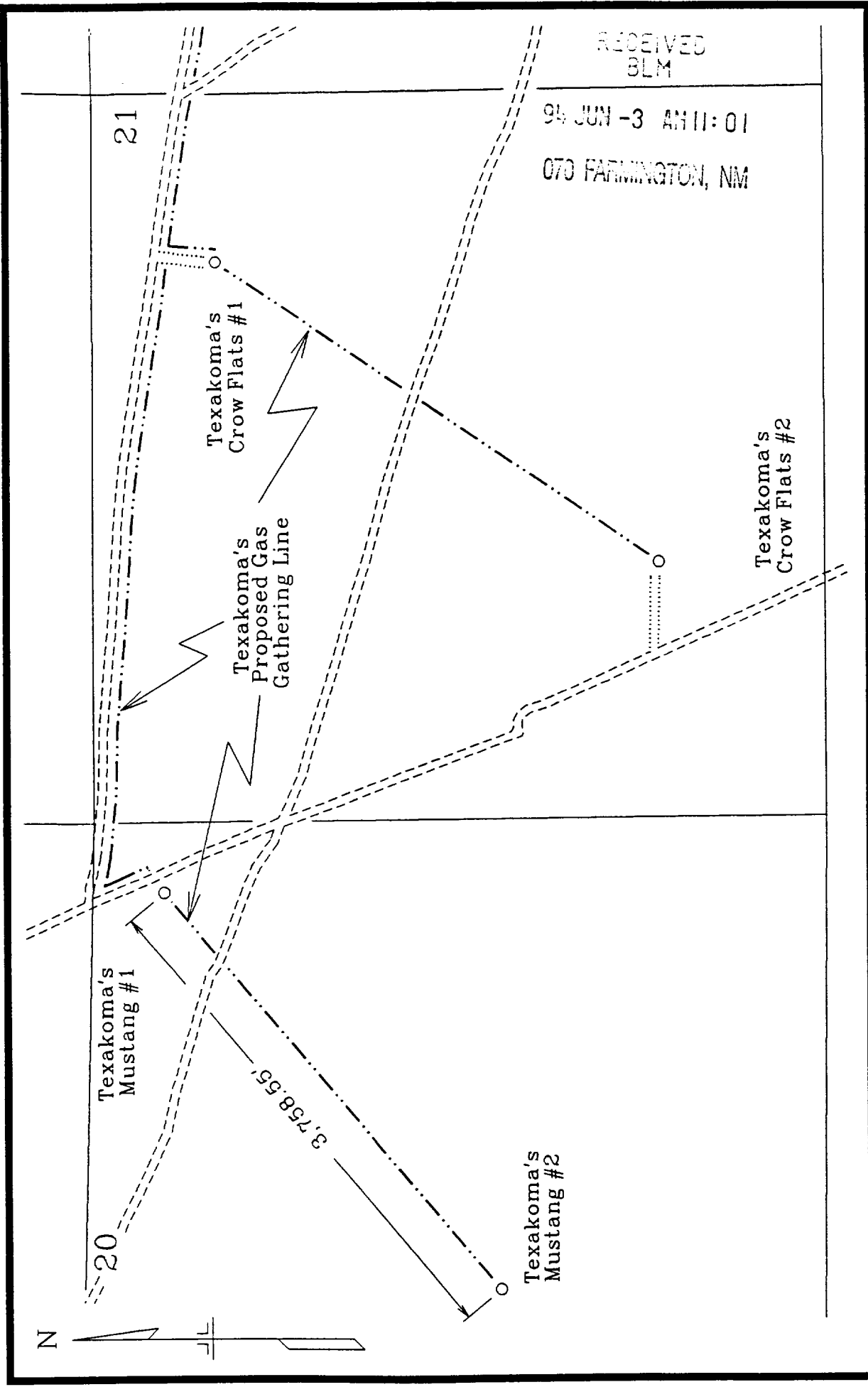
