

PRO New Mexico , Inc. proposes to install a 3" SDR-11 poly pipeline to gather gas from this well and transport to a CDP point on the Gallegos Com #5 location in the SE/4 of Section 32, T26N, R11W. PRO New Mexico will install a 2" meter facility on this location to properly allocate production. Anticipated working pressure is 20psiq. Burial depth will be 36-48 inches. A 2" ESD valve will be installed on location to prevent over pressure of the line. line will be pressure tested to 100psig during installation. proposed line route will follow existing Giant Exploration and Production and Gas Co. of New Mexico right of ways. Installation will be with a Ditch Witch type (rubber tired) trencher followed by Twenty feet of offset will be a truck pulling a spool trailer. maintained from the closest line and all proposed construction activity will be limited to the existing ROW disturbance. Pro has investigated the extent of prior archeological clearance work and determined that the portion of the right of way from PI#5 to EOL was covered by two previous surveys as outlined in the attached letter from Moore Anthropological Research. No sites or TCP's were identified by either survey and clearance based on past work has been requested.

Surface ownership is Tribal Trust in the SW/4 and Indian Allotted in the NW/4. The west half of section 5 is dedicated to this well and PRO New Mexico, Inc. has the oil and gas lease for the west half.

Dear Dr. Downer:

We have been contacted by Property Management & Consulting, Inc. (P.O. Box 2596, Farmington, N.M. 87499), agent for Pro New Mexico, Inc. (141 E. Palace Ave., Santa Fe, N.M. 87501). They would like to build a pipeline in an existing pipeline right-of-way (ROW) in T.25N, R.11W, Section 5, Huerfrano Chapter, San Juan County, New Mexico. The pipeline would tie in existing well Garcia Navajo 5K#2. A copy of the survey plat and topographic map are enclosed. The pipeline proposed by Pro New Mexico will stay within the disturbed existing ROW (Giant and Gas Co. of New Mexico already have lines here). A three inch polypipe will be put in at about 4 foot deep using a ditchwitch, pickup truck, and spool trailer.

The south 2/3 of the ROW falls within the area previously surveyed for this project by Tomlinson (1992:6-8). Tomlinson found two isolated loci (one flake and one tested cobble) and no archaeological sites, current cultural manifestations, or traditional cultural properties. This report was approved after further TCP research was conducted.

The north 1/3 of the ROW falls within the area previously surveyed for another pipeline (Giant Exploration and Production Co.) conducted earlier this year (Hammack 1993). Hammack did not find any isolated loci, archaeological sites, or traditional cultural properties. This report has been approved by your office.

We request that you examine the enclosed documents along with the two cited reports, and make a determination concerning archaeological clearance for this project. If you need any additional information please let us know.
