A gas transmission line is proposed to go from the Mustang Flats #1 to the N. East edge of Sec 20 (as illustrated), approximately 791.4" of 4" SDR-7 poly-pipe. The 4" SDR-7 pipe has a maximum working pressure of 260 psi at 74° F. It is our intention to operate the line at $\pm$ 50 psi. The attached plat prepared by Texakoma Oil & Gas Corporation illustrates the proposed location of the Gathering line.

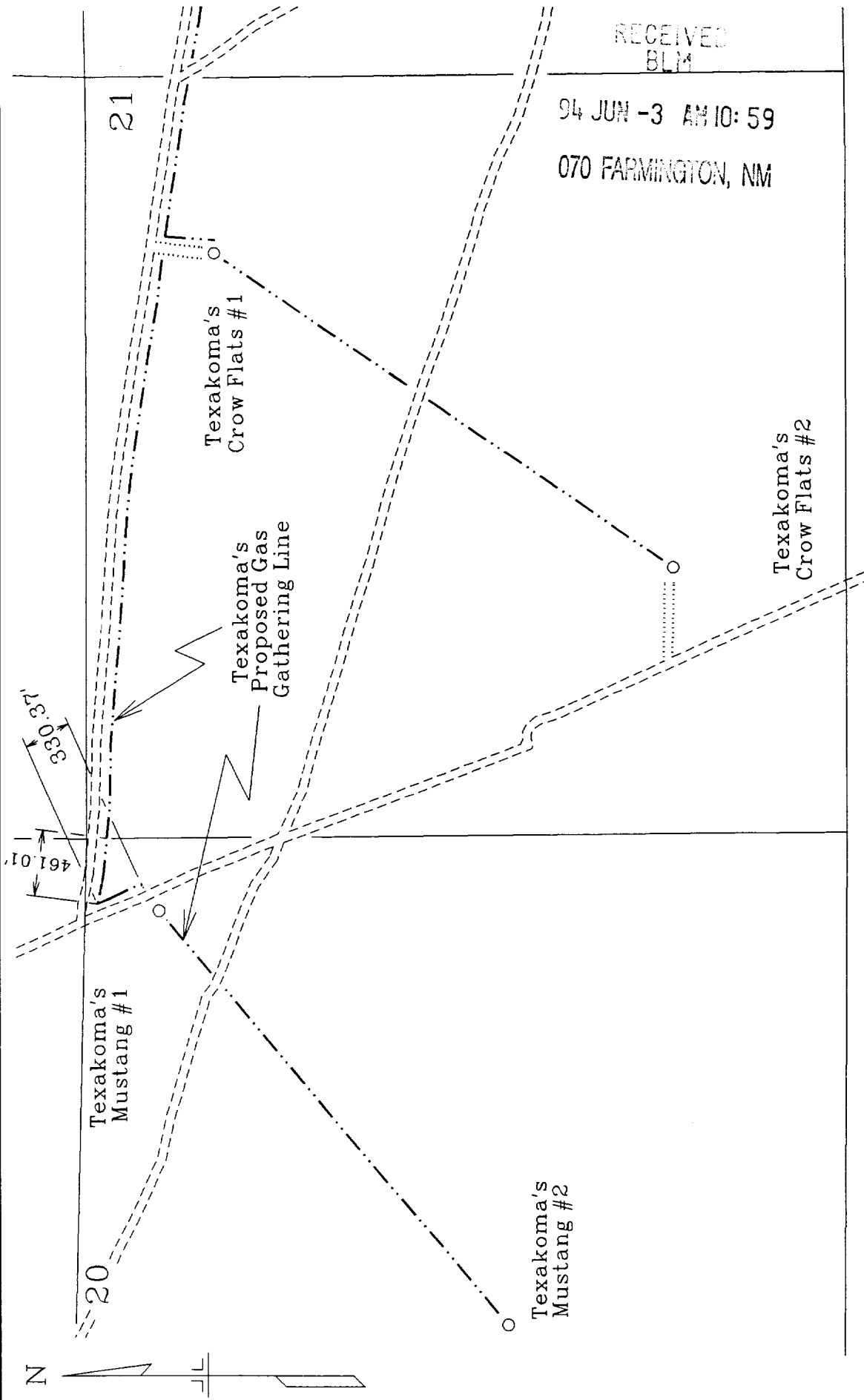
