This well was disconnected from El Paso Natural Gas Company's pipeline on August 22, 1970 due to its inability to produce natural gas into the pipeline. Total gas produced from first production in December, 1963 until pipeline disconnection in 1970 was 10,790 MCF and 2,306 barrels of oil. Most of the gas was produced the first 13 days it was on the line.

We are now testing this well as to its capabilities to produce oil as it appears to be an oil well rather than a gas well. If testing reveals that this is in fact, an oil well, we will be requesting the New Mexico Conservation Commission to change its classification from a noncommercial gas well to an oil well and produce same.
