DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled out from under 5-1/2" casing set at 1884' after testing aqueous permeability to 1885' and bailed 30 gallons of water per hour. Drilled ahead and encountered oil show at 1921' and bailed 25 gallons oil and 27 gallons water per hour. Drilled to 1960' and bailed 5 gallons oil and 37 gallons water per hour for 2 hours. Drilled to total depth of 1998' and bailed 1/2 gallon oil and 42 gallons water per hour for 6 hours. Run logs and released cable tool rig November 16, 1960 pending further operations.
