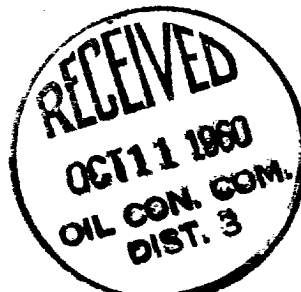

DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

Spudded 12" hole on October 4, 1960 and drilled to 125'. Set 18-3/4" casing at 122' with 90 sacks cement containing 25 calcium chloride. Circulated 12 sacks cement. After waiting on cement, tested 18-3/4" casing with 400 psi, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced to 12" hole at 125' and resumed drilling operations with cable tools.
