

Dear Mr. Bush:

We recently completed the field operations to downhole commingle and add Lewis Pay the subject well. In accordance to DHC-2043, the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the NMOCD shall determine the proper production allocation.

Prior to downhole commingling, the Pictured Cliffs was producing 35 MCFD. The combined Pictured Cliffs and Mesa Verde is flowing 345 MCFD and 1/4 BOPD after two weeks of stabilized production. It is recommended the production allocation be as follows:

> Gas Oil **Pictured Cliffs** 10% 0% Mesa Verde 90% 100%
