Will run back-kill packer & 600 cts deep chokes immediately above packer. 1/2 sec. 36, 120 cts. dedicated to Blanco Verde, & 20/4 sec. 36, 120 cts. dedicated to the Flathead Cliff.

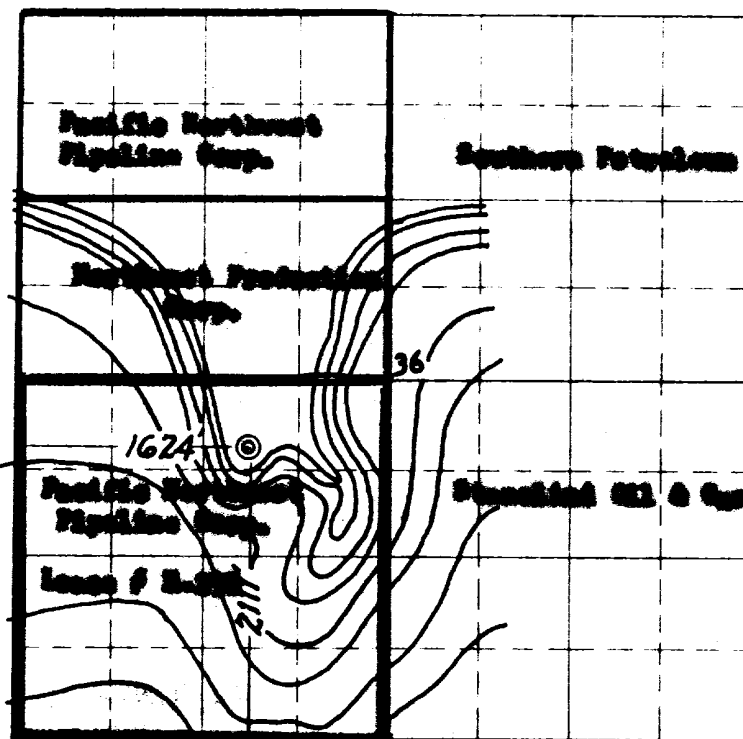
