ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

## BY THE COMMISSION

This cause came on for hearing at 8 o'clock a.m. on June 24, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Uta, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this and day of July, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence address, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Eivis A. Utu, and being fully advised in the premises.

## FINDA:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has just addition of this cause and the subject matter thereof,
- (2) That the applicant, Casikins Cili Gempany, is the ewner and operator of the Breach "F" Well No. PMD-8, located 990 feet from the Morth line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 34, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMP-4, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant proposes to triple complete the above-described Breech "F" Well No. PMD-8 in such a meaner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Gliffs Pool through the easing-tableg annulus with a blood-off string of 3/4-inch EUE tubing, the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through 3½-inch seamless tableg from 5365 feet to 4688 feet thence through a crossever assembly into 1½-inch EUE tubing to the surface, and the production of gas from the Dakota formation through 2-3/8-inch EUE tubing.
