ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8 o'clock a.m. on June 24, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvin A. Uta, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 2nd day of July, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvin A. Uta, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Caulkins Oil Company, is the owner and operator of the Breech "F" Well No. PMD-8, located 990 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 34, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant proposes to triple complete the above-described Breech "F" Well No. PMD-8 in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool through the casing-tubing annulus with a bleed-off string of 3/4-inch EUE tubing, the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool through 3/4-inch seamless tubing from 5365 feet to 4488 feet thence through a crossover assembly into 1 1/4-inch EUE tubing to the surface, and the production of gas from the Dakota formation through 2-3/8-inch EUE tubing.
