It is proposed to pull 3/4" EUE tubing now set @ 3157' and salvage same, then pull 1 1/2" tubing now set in Packer set @ 4600' and salvage same. 2 3/8" tubing and seal assy now set in Packers @ 4600' and 7370' will be pulled, seal assy removed then 2 3/8" will be run to approx 7550' with seals in Packer to separate Pictured Cliffs from commingled zones below. 1" NW 10rd tubing will be run to approx 3200' from Pictured Cliffs Production.
