THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY POR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN 27-5 UNIT WELL NO. 67 LOCATED IN THE NN/4 NE/4 OF SECTION 31, TOMBSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NORTH, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MARHER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE SOUTH BLANCO-PICTURED CLINGS POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO-MESAVERDE POOL.



OF THE OIL COMMERVATION CONMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Matural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 19, 1961, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 67, located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 31, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blance-Pictured Cliffs Poel and the production of gas from the Blance-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on thes 8th day of January, 1962, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 67 located in the NM/4 ME/4 of Section 31, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blance-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blance-Mesaverde Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Poel or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
