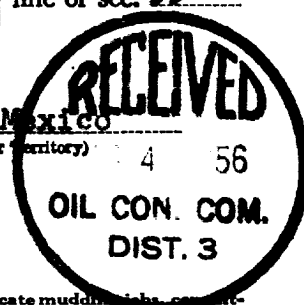

DETAILS OF WORK

After setting 2197' of 5 1/2" liner on bottom @ 6200' w/100 sx cement, top of liner @ 4003'. Temp. survey top of cement @ 4968'. Set retainer @ 3918' and cement over top of liner w/150 sx cement. Pressure 1000#. Survey bottom of cement @ 4790'. Tested w/1500# before and after drilling plugs to 6165' PBSD. Tested O.K. No break.
