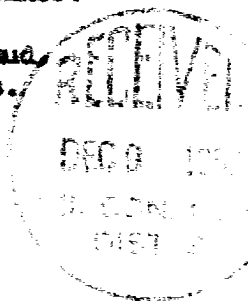
The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is 2705 ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Filled hole from 300' to 110' with heavy drilling mud.
