

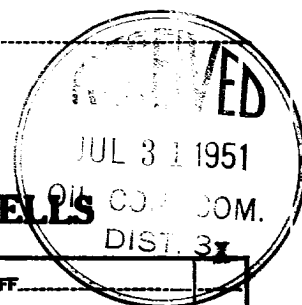

Drilled plug, closed runs on DOR, pressured up to 500# and held thirty minutes on July 26, 1951.
