Under the previsions of Rule 112-A (c) El Pase Natural Gas Company, made application to the New Maxies Oil Conservation Commission on July 25, 1958, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 34, located 1090 feet from the South line and 890 feet from the West line of Section 30, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, MMPM, Rie Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the South Blance Pictured Cliffs Poel and gas from the Blance Mesaverde Poel.

New, on this 30th day of July, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations:
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acroage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the preposed dwal completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consenant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Kl Pase Natural Cas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 34, located 1090 feet from the South line and 890 feet from the West line of Section 30, Tourship 27 North, Range 5 West, HMPM, Rie Arriba County, Now Maxico, in such a manner has to permit the production of gas from the South Blance Pictured Cliffs Peel and gas from the Blance Messaverde Peel, through the easing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

SMOKIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Section 112-A, as amended by Order No. R-1214.

PROVIDED FULTHER. That the operator shall make any and all tests, including segregation and packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blance Mesaverde Peal, commencing in the year 1959, and whenever the packer is disturbed, but not excluding any other tests and/or determinations as deemed necessary by the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED. That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights;

upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-sense production in the interests of conservation.
