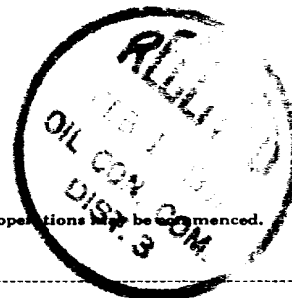

It is intended to drill a dual complete a well in the Pictured Cliffs formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs formation & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde & a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated Total Depth 5990'.

Casing program:

3 3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
9 5/8" at 3423' with 250 sacks cement.
1 1/2" liner at 5990' with 300 sacks cement.

The N/2 of Section 25 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde.
The NW/4 of section 25 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.

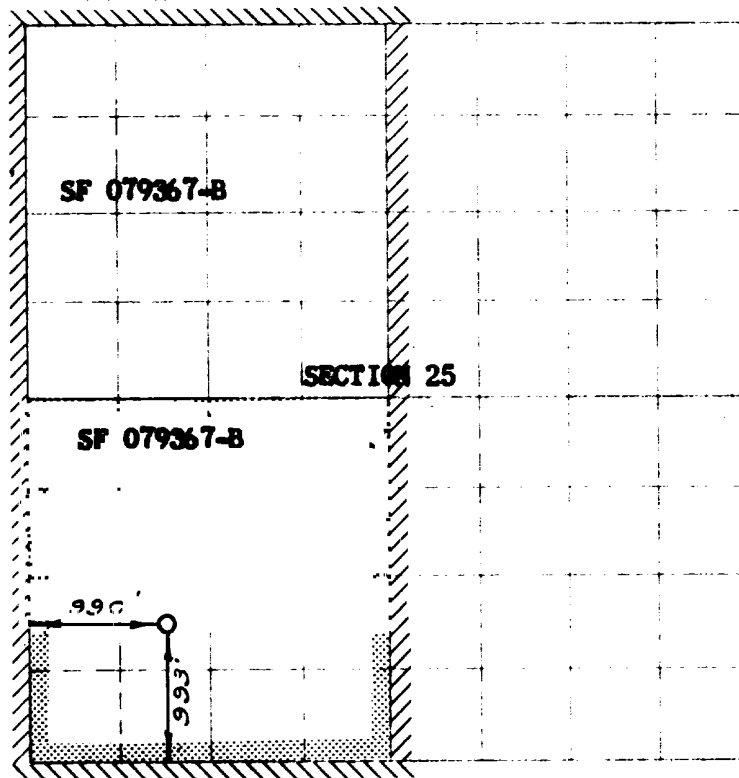
