We propose to drill the above well to a total depth of 6000' with Rotary Tools. We expect to test the following zones at the following approximate depths if indicative of oil or gas show:

We expect to test any other zones that appear productive of oil or gas. **Approximately 300' of 10-1/4" Surface casing w/approximately 300' on cement, approximately 4300' of 7-1/8" Intermediate casing with approximately 100' on cement, approximately 2000' of 5-1/2" liner w/approximately 200' on cement on bottom and will cement top of liner w/approximately 200' on cement. We propose to perforate and mud-waterproof productive zones in the Pictured Cliffs and Moon Verde for completion.**

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
