APPLICATION OF EL PASC NATURAL COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS RINCON UNIT WELL NO. 129 LOCATED IN THE NE/4 SW /4 OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO-MESAVERDF POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO-DAKOTA POOL.



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Cil Conservation Commission on June 3, 1966, for permission to dually complete its Rincon Unit Well No. 129 located in the NE/4 SW/~ of Section 29, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Elanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the South Blanco-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 23rd day of June, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as a rescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are Seasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE OF DERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Rincon Unit Well No. 129 located in the NE/4 SW/4 of Section 29. Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMFM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from the South Blanco-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 42-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the South Blasse askota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisidiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
