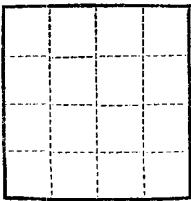

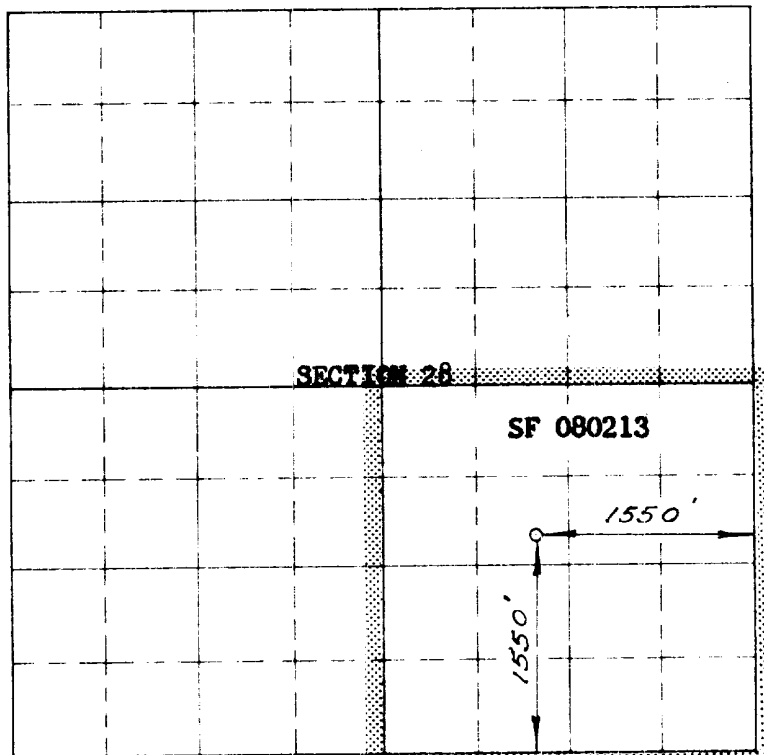
WELL LOCATION AND/OR GAS PRORATION PLAT
