DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Pictured Cliffs formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs formation & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde & a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated Total Depth 5865'.

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 150 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 3689' with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" liner at 3640-5865' with 300 sacks cement.

The E/2 of Section 25 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde.
The NE/4 of Section 25 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

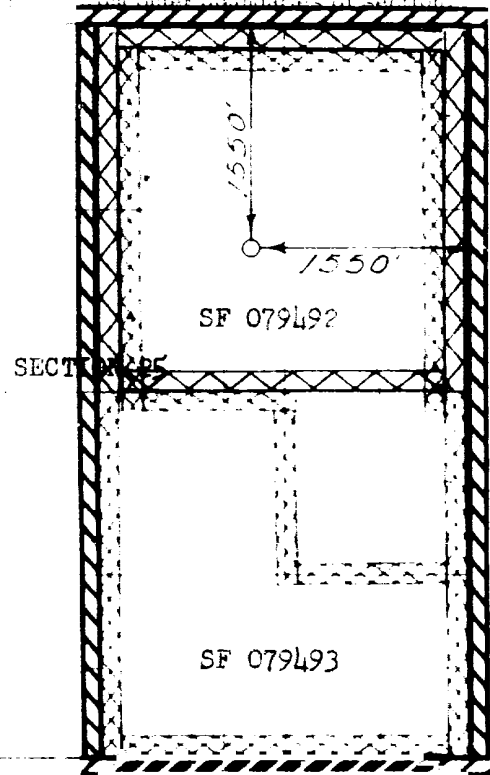
