Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 28, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Champlin Well No. 7-25 located in Unit H of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of November, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Champlin Well No. 7-25 located in Unit H of Section 25, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete. operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packerleakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

ET IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
