It is intended to drill a dual complete a well in the Dakota formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the middle of the Greenhorn formation. A 7" liner will be set. Mud circulation will be used thru the Dakota formation & production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be performed & fractured. S. T. D. 7740'.

- 5 7/8" at 3340' w/200 sks. cement circulated to surface.
- 5 7/8" at 7365' w/800 sks. cement.
- 5 7/8" at 7740' w/100 sks. cement.

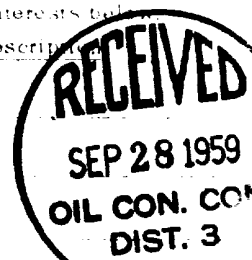

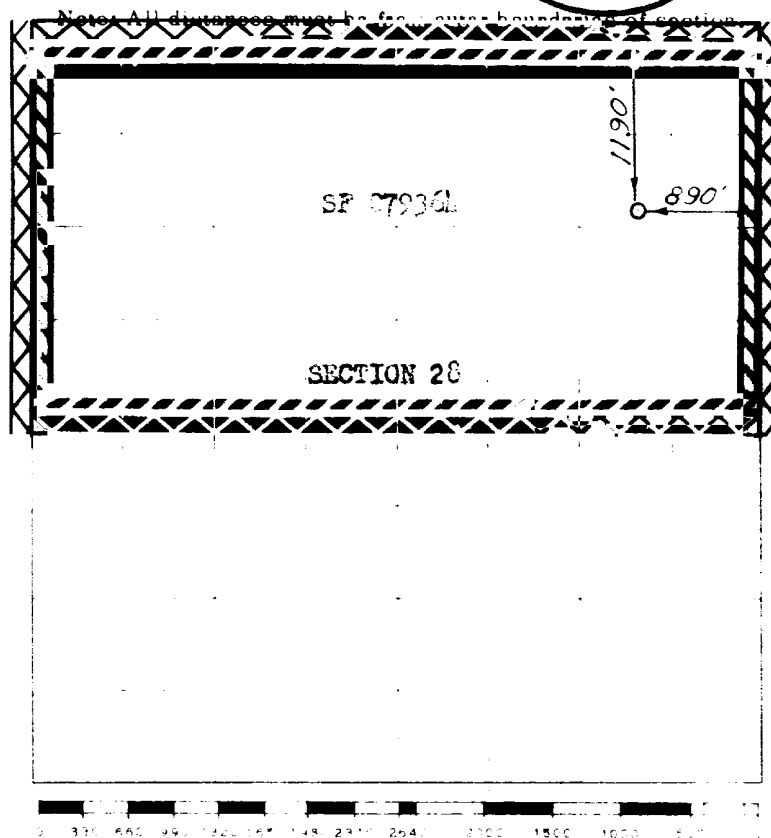
