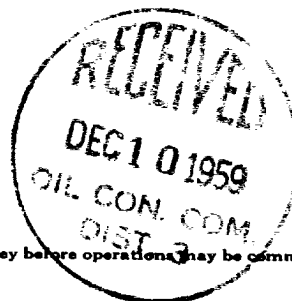
DETAILS OF WORK

 Ran 12 joints, 9 5/8", 40.00', H-80 casing (373'), 94 joints 9 5/8", 36.00' J-55 casing (2968') for a total of 3341' set at 3353', cemented with 120 sacks regular cement, 26 Gal, 1/4 cu. ft. Gilsonite/sk, followed by 50 sacks neat cement.
