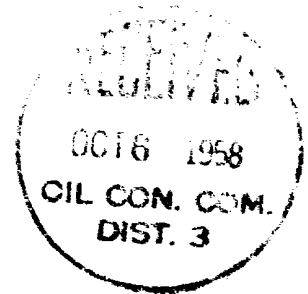


THE APPLICATION OF MAGNOLIA PETROLEUM COMPANY
FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF
ITS JICARILLA "F" WELL NO. 5, LOCATED 990
FEET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 990 FEET FROM THE
WEST LINE OF SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH,
RANGE 3 WEST, NMPM, RIO ARriba COUNTY, NEW MEXICO,
IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF
GAS FROM THE BLANCO MESAVERDE POOL AND THE
PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED
CLIFFS FORMATION.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Magnolia Petroleum Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 8, 1958, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "F" Well No. 5, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 23, Township 27 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Formation,

Now, on this 2nd day of October, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

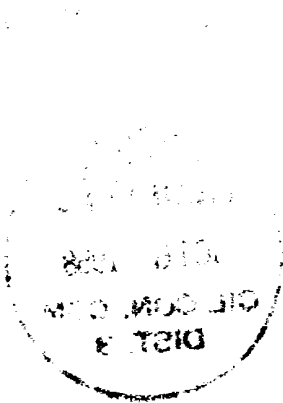
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Magnolia Petroleum Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "F" Well No. 5, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 23, Township 27 North, Range 3 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Formation, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: that jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities
