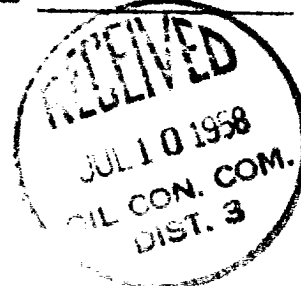
Dear Mr. Arnold:
