This letter is to inform you that El Paso Natural Gas Company is in the process of dually completing the following well:

San Juan 27-4 Unit No. 13 (PM) NE 20-27-4

This well will be dually completed in the Pictured Cliffs-Mesa Verde as a gas-gas dual. A packer will be installed on the 2-3/8" tubing between the zones with a sidedoor choke installed in the 2-3/8" tubing above the production packer. Upon final successful completion a formal application for administrative approval will be made to the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe.
