DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Pictured Cliffs formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs formation & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde & a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated Total Depth 5600'.

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.

7 5/8" at 3360' with 250 sacks cement.

5 1/2" liner at 5600' with 300 sacks cement.

The E/2 of Section 21 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde.

The NE/4 of Section 21 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.

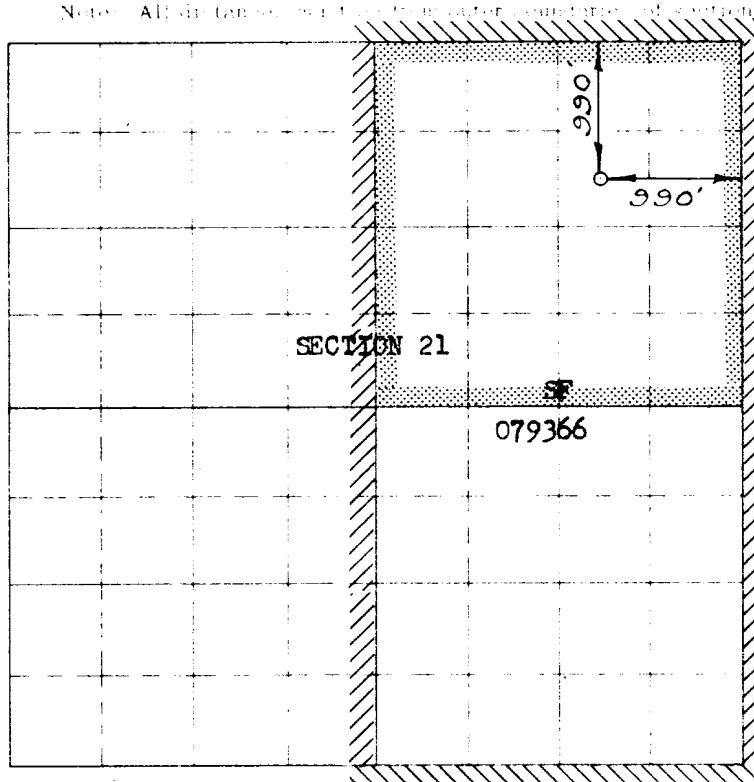
