DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools thru the Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs and set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde and production casing will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated and fractured. Estimated T.D. 5400'.

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 3080' with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" at 5400' with 150 sacks cement.

The E/2 of Section 19 is dedicated to this well.

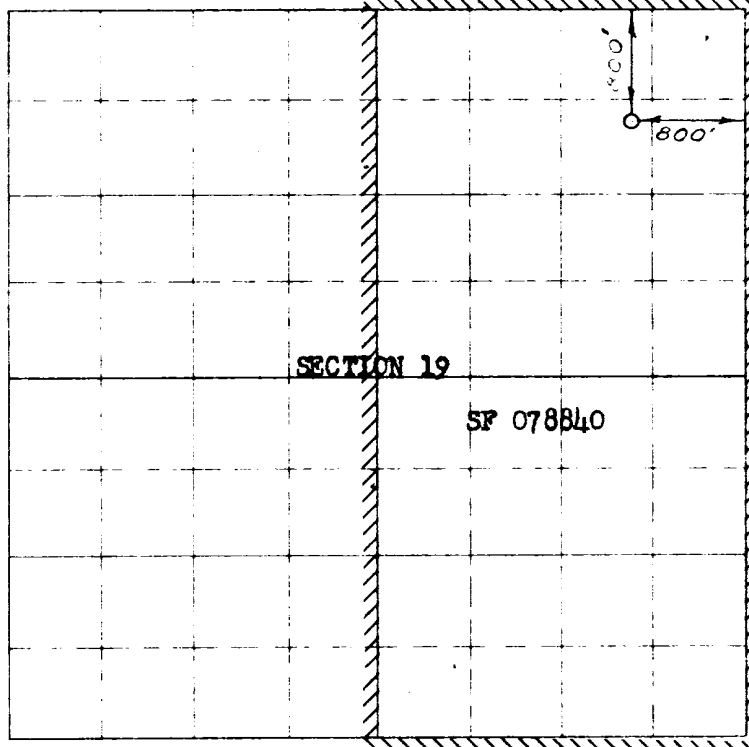
