Dear Mr. Porter:

Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation has staked Unit 27-5, Well No. 38-16 located 1580' FNL and 2125' FNL, in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 16, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 of Section 16, is dedicated to this well.

We request that under the provisions of Rule No. 1, Section C, of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blance Gas Pool, as set forth in Order No. E-110, that you grant approval for Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation to drill this unorthodox location. The unorthodox location is necessary because of the extreme topographic relief.

Southern Petroleum Company, the only offset acreage owner within a radius of 750 feet of the proposed well, has been notified of the unorthodox location and has been requested for a waiver to drill same.

Enclosed is a letter written to Southern Petroleum Company notifying them of the unorthodox location and asking for a waiver to be sent to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
