Reference is made to your application for approval of a 299.89-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, NMPM
Section 14: E/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Rincon Unit 151 Well, located 1170 feet from the North line and 1640 feet from the East line of said Section 14.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 299.89 acres.
