Dear Mr. Arnold:

Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation requests tenative approval to drill and dually complete Indian P #l in the Pictured Cliffs and Mesa Verde formations.

Indian P #1 is located 1386 FNL, and 1236 FEL, Section No. 16, Township 27N, Range 3 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The well is classified as a Wildcat in the Pictured Cliffs, and is a Blanco Mesa Verde Pool Extension.

Attached is original receipt for registered letter notifyinc Magnolia Petroleum Company of our intention to dually complete Indian P #1.

Our procedure for drilling the well will be as follows:

- 1. Set 7-5/8" casing at 4070.
- 2. Drill with gas to 6200' to the Mesa Verde formation and set a  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " liner at this point.
- 3. Selectively perforate and frac the Mesa Verde formation.
- 4. Set bridge plug and selectively perforate and frac the Pictured Cliffs formation.
- 5. Clean out to Total Depth.
- 6. Set tubing stinger at 6150', Lane-Wells hookwall packer at 5650' and Otis side-door choke at 5620' on 2-3/8"

  O. D. tubing.
- 7. Install straight through mandril in side-door choke and produce the Mesa Verde formation through the tubing and

the Pictured Cliffs formation through the tubing-casing annulus.

The dual completion of Indian P #1 will allow Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation to test the reserves in two formations, and will allow us the opportunity to produce both formations from one well, thus reducing the drilling costs in the area.
