On 10-16-61 T.D. 3759. Ran 99 joints 7" 20#, J-55 casing (3743') set at 3745' with 90 sks cement, 25 gal, 1/4 cu.ft. Strata-Crete "6"/sk, followed by 50 sks regular. Held 1500#/30 minutes.
