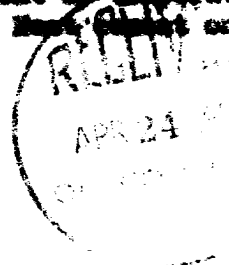

### DETAILS OF WORK

On April 2, 1956, Total Depth 5593'.

Run 54 joints 5 1/2", 15.50#, J-55 liner from 3295' to 5548' (2253'), w/100 sacks regular cement, 100 sacks Pozmix with 6% gel and 1/8" Floccs per sack, followed with 50 sacks Neat cement. Top of the cement by temperature survey at 3630'. Squared top of the liner with 100 sacks Neat cement on April 3, 1956.
