THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PREMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN 28-6 UNIT WELL NO. 80 LOCATED 1650 FEET FROM THE NORTH LINE AND 1750 FRET FROM THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NHPM, RIO ARRIBA GOUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO MESAVERDE POOL, AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED CLIFFS FORMATION.



## OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the previsions of Rule 112-A (c) El Pase Natural Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 15, 1958, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 80, located 1650 feet from the North line and 1750 feet from the Rast line of Section 12, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool, and the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Formation.

New on this 25th day of September, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the previsions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of effect acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the preposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consenant with good conservation practices.

## 17 IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Pase Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-6 Unit Well No. 80 lecated 1650 feet from the North line and 1750 feet from the East line of Section 12, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, MMPH, Rie Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Poel and the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Formation, through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWE/ER, that applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER. that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blance Mesaverde Peel.

IT IS FURTHER CRIDERED: that jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities

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to regular single-sene production in the interests of conservation.
