ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 10, 1959, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 102 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool adjacent to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 25th day of November, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 102 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool adjacent to the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, an application was made to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 10, 1955, for permission to drill a well in San Juan 27 North, Unit 111 No. 102 located in the SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, MPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool adjacent to the San Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco Reserve Pool.

On this 28th day of November, 1955, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Commission:

(1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Sub section (a) of Rule 115-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

(2) That a copy of the information was sent to the operators of other acreage have been duly notified and

(3) That no objections have been received within the working period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste of in gas or other rights.

(5) That the need/sides of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS ORDERED AND GRANTED:

That the application herein, filed by National Gas Company, do and the same is hereby authorized to comply with the San Juan 27 North, Unit 111 No. 102 located in the SE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, MPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool adjacent to the San Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco Reserve Pool through a well/sides of tubing.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That application shall comply, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 115-A.



PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
