

DETAILS OF WORK

On 10-3-61 Total Depth 3620'. Ran 91 joints 7", 20#, J-55 casing (3608') set at 3619', with 80 sks cement, 4 1/2 gal, 1/2 cu. ft. Strata-Crete "6"/sk., followed by 50 sks regular.

On 10-7-61 Total Depth 5746'. Ran 71 joints 4 1/2", 10.5# J-55 casing (2224') set at 3515 to 5737' with 210 sks cement, 4 1/2 gal, 1/4 cu. ft. fine Gilsomite/sk, and 1/8# Floccle/sk. Held 1500#/30 minutes.
