DETAILS OF WORK

It was originally intended to drill and complete this well in the Mesa Verde formation only. On the basis of information obtained from the Electrical and Micro Logs, however, it has been decided to complete the well in both the Mesa Verde and Pictured Cliffs formations as a gas-gas dual. The casing program, methods of drilling, circulating fluids, and estimated total depth remain the same as they appeared on the original intention to drill. Dedication of acreage should be revised as follows:

The E/2 of Section 5 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde formation.
The NE/4 of Section 5 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs formation.

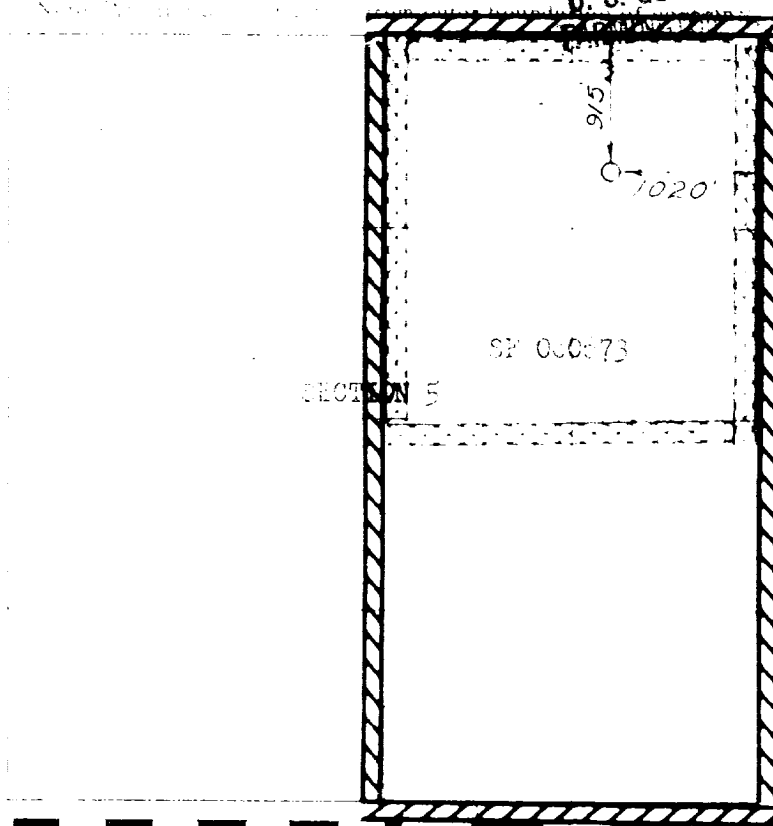
