

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL COMMISSION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Commission on July 15, 1951, for permission to install compressor equipment at San Juan 28-3 Unit No. 173 located in Unit I of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 1 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to damage as little as possible the Santa Biscoco-Pioche gas pipeline.

Now, on this 30th day of July, 1951, the Secretary:

Directs that: (1) That application be denied unless the location of Rule 115-A to the Commission's rules and regulations:

(2) That application be denied unless the location of Rule 115-A to the Commission's rules and regulations; and

that the cause of denial be set forth as follows: before a decision is made upon the new location, the Commission will consider the following factors:

(3) That the object of the new location is to serve the same area as the existing location, and

(4) That the mechanism of the proposed unit will cause waste and pollution to the environment of the proposed unit.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application is denied, El Paso Natural Gas Company, for San Juan 28-3 Unit No. 173 located in Unit I of Section 17, Township 28 North, Range 1 West, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to damage as little as possible the Santa Biscoco-Pioche gas pipeline.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That application shall be granted, subject to the issuance of a permit by the State of New Mexico, if it is issued under the authority of the State of New Mexico, Rule 115-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That application shall be granted, subject to the issuance of a permit by the State of New Mexico, if it is issued under the authority of the State of New Mexico, Rule 115-A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED; That application to the Commission may be filed at any time after the issuance of the permit by the State of New Mexico, if it is issued under the authority of the State of New Mexico, Rule 115-A.
