

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2118

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 2, 1974, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 206, located in Unit B, Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation.

Now, on this 9th day of July, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the waiting period prescribed by said rule may be waived;
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 206, located in Unit B, Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation through parallel strings of 2 7/8 inch casing cemented in a common wellbore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

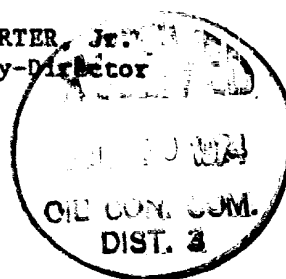
PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-11, El Paso Natural Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 1, 1974, for permission to finally complete the San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 10, located in Unit B, Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMTW, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco Formation, Little Pool and from the Chacra Formation.

Now, on this 25th day of July, 1974, the Secretary-Inspector finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11-11 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
- (3) That the waiting period provided by said rule has been met.
- (4) That the proposed final completion will not cause water to remain unproductive.
- (5) That the location of the proposed final completion is in accordance with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and is hereby authorized to finally complete the San Juan 28-7 Unit Well No. 10, located in Unit B, Section 20, Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMTW, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco Formation, Little Pool and from the Chacra Formation through parallel strings of 2 7/8 inch casing cemented in a concrete wellbore.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall comply, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-11.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take proper-leakage tests, record completion and annular integrity.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction of this case as hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
