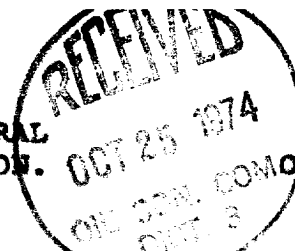


THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.



ORDER NO. MC-2150

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 15, 1974, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 73 located in Unit H of Section 17, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 16th day of October, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 73 located in Unit H of Section 17, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 15, 1974, for permission to install a well in Unit H of Section 17, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, WPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Tapatio-Blanco Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of October, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

(3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights;

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
