

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL  
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2237

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 28, 1976, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 125 located in Unit G of Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 30th day of January, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 125 located in Unit G of Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

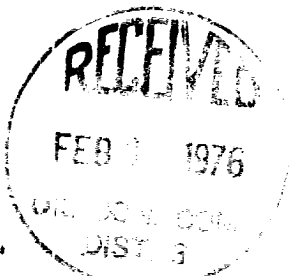
PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

That the applicant herein, the Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the state is hereby authorized to dual complete the Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 125 located in Unit 7 of Section 8, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, T10N, R4W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Tapachito-Piedra Blanca Pool and from the Pinedo-Mesavida Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall take proper measures to protect the completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
