## NORTHWEST NEW MEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- 2. A packer leakage test shall be commenced on each multiply completed well within seven days after actual completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the order authorizing the multiple completion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and/or chemical or fixe-ture treatment, and whenever semedial work has been done on a well duting which the packer or the rubing have been disturbed. Tests shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when required by the Division.
- 2. At least 72 limits prior to the commencement of any packer leakage test, the operator shall mostly the Division in actions of the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators thall also be so notified.
- 3. The parket leakage test shall commence when both zones of the dual completion are shut in for pressure mabilitation. Both zones shall remain shut-in until the well-head pressure in each his stabilited, provided however, that they need not remain shut-in more than were dark.
- 4. For the Test No. 1, one zone of the dual completion shall be produced at the normal rate of production while the other zone remains shut-in. Such test shall be continued for seven data in the case of a gas well and for 24 hours in the case of an oil well. Note: if, on an initial grader leakage test, a gas well is being flowed to the autosphere due to the lack of a pijeline connection the flow period shall be three hours.
- 5. Inflicing completion of Flow Test No. 1, the well shall again be shut-in, in accordance with Eurograph 3 above.
- 6. Theo Ten'No. 2 shall be conducted even though no leak was indicated during Flow Ten No. 1, Procedure for Flow Ten No. 2 is to be the same as for Flow Ten No. 1 everys

- that the previously produced zone shall remain shut in while the zone which was previously shut in is produced.
- 7. Pressures for gas-zone term must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: I hours term: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow-period, at fifteen-minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and at hourly intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. 7-day term: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midway point) and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have previously shown questionable test data.
- 24 hour oil zone testi: all presuires, throughout the entire test, shall be continuously measured and remoded with recording pressure gauges the accuracy of which must be checked at least twice, once at the heginning and once at the end of each test, with a deadweight pressure gauge. If a well it a gas-oil or an oil-gas dual completion, this recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with deadweight pressures as required above being taken on the gas sone.
- B. The results of the above described tests shall be filed in triplicate within 13 days after completion of the test. Tests shall be filed with the Aziet District Office of the New Meuro Oil Conservation Desirion on Northwest New Means Packet Leakage Test Issum Revised 10-01-78 with all dead-eight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatures (gas zones only) and gravity and GOR (oil zones only).
