## ADMINISTRATIVE CROSS OF THE CIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Caulkins Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on September 13, 1976 for permission to dually complete its Bracch Well No. 332 located in Unit A of Section 23, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Rianco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Charge formation adjacent to the Otero-Charge Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of October, 1976, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations:
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause was a nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

## IT IS THEMEFORE ORDERED;

That the applicant herein, Caulkins Gil Company, he and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Breech Well How.
312 located in Unit A of Section 23, Township 26 North, Renge Towest, MMPM, Rio Azriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Fistured Cliffs Pool and from the Chaora formation adjacent to the Otero-Chaora Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED NOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS PURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
