Dear Mr. Routson:

Our records show that the subject well has new 7 inch 20 pound K-55 casing set at 4015 feet.

It is our belief that the well can be better completed at this time with 5 inch casing cemented above a packer set at approximately 4600 feet with a slotted liner below the packer to or near 4710. The well can then be tubed.

This would allow 2 7/8 or $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch to be used for casing if and when the hole is deepened to include the Point Lookout formation.

This would also eliminate any possible theft by zones in the shale above the fracture you will be producing from.
