THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2688

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provision of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on July 9, 1980, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 35A located in Unit F of Section 33, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of July, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights;
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 35A located in Unit F of Section 33, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

If, after said twenty-day period, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.

NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in one or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.
