NORTHWEST NEWMEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. A packer leakage test shall be commenced on each multiply completed well within sever days after actual completion of the well, and annually interester as prescribed by the order antoning the multiple completion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and or chemical or fracture treatment, and wherever remedia, work has been done on a well during which the packer or the tabing have been disturbed. Tests shall use one taken at any time that communication is suspected or other requested by the Division.
- 2. At least 72 nows prior to the commence next of any packer leasurge test, the operator shall ments the Dysson in writing of the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall use a so by tifled.
- 3. The Sucser leakage test shall commune when both zones of the dual completion are shart-in for pressure stabilization. Both zones shall remain shart-in until the weil-hend prossure in out it mis stabilized provided however, that they need not remain shut-in more than seven days.
- 4. For blow lost No. 1, one zonior, fittle analicompletion shall be produced at the normal rate of production while the other cone rotation shuffly fiscillates shall be continued for several days in the case of a gas were and to 2% boars at the case of an oil well. Note it from an initial packer leakage test a gas well is being flowed to the atmit sphere due to lack of a pipeline connection the flow beta a small be time accura-

- that the previously produced zone shall remain shut-in while the zone which was previously shut-in is produced
- Pressures for gas-zone tests must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows. 3 hours tests immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at fifteen-ninate intervals during the first hour thereof, and at hourly intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. 7-day tests, immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at least one time during each flow period, at approximately the midway pointy and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have previously shown questionable test data.
- 24-hour oil zone tests, all pressures, throughout the entire test, shall be continuously measured and recorded with recording pressure gauges the accuracy of which must be checked at least twice, once at the beginning and once at the end of each test, with a deadweight pressure gauge. If a well is a gas-oil or an oil-gas dual completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with deadweight pressures as required above being taken on the gas zone.
- 8. The results of the above-described tests shall be filed in triplicate within 15 days after completion of the test. Tests shall be filed with the Aznee District Office of the New Mexico Offi Conservation Division on Northwest New Mexico Packer Leakage Test Form Revised 16-01-78 with all deadweight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatures (gas zeroes only) and gracity and GOR roil zones only).
