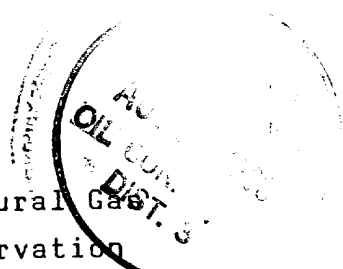


ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on July 24, 1980, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 99A located in Unit C of Section 16, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 31st day of July, 1980, the Division Director finds:

- (1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;
- (3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 99A located in Unit C of Section 16, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.

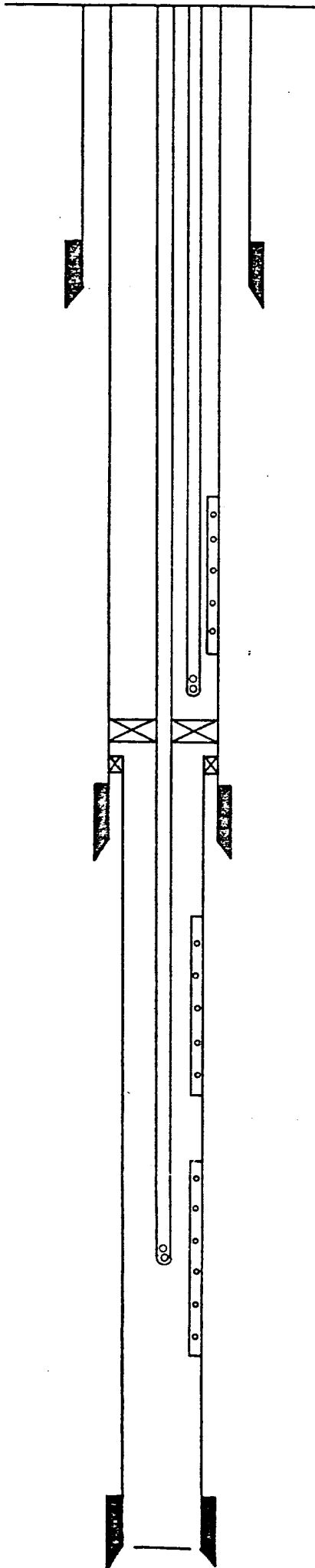
*Should waivers from all offset operators not accompany an application for administrative approval, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission will hold the application for a period of twenty (20) days from date of receipt by the Commission's Santa Fe office. If, after said twenty-day period, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.

NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard proration unit in one or more of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.

Point Lookout formation will be selectively perforated and
sand water fractured.

2 3/8", 4.7#, EUE Mesa Verde tubing set at 6660'.

4 1/2", 10.5#, J-55 liner will be set from approximately
4295' to 6650' with sufficient cement to circulate top
of liner at 4295'.
