

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2695
(CORRECTED)

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on July 24, 1980, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 138 located in Unit 0 of Section 16, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 31st day of July, 1980, the Division Director finds:

(1) That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage;

(3) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-4 Unit Well No. 138 located in Unit 0 of Section 16, Township 27 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
