

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL  
GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2863

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on May 22, 1981, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit No. 98E located in Unit L of Section 14, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 19th day of June, 1981, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that there are no other operators of offset acreage.
3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit No. 98-E located in Unit L of Section 14, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.


PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
